CORRECTIONS/EXTRA CREDIT

Corrections on Homework and Quizzes only (Students will be given one day to get one day to get corrections turned in after it has been graded and returned to them).

Research Paper (at least 3 pages, correct grammar and spelling) on a relevant topic.

Extra Practice Sheets (these can be completed when needed, to help students that have grades in the danger zone.

DISCIPLINE

1st- Verbal Warning

2nd- Written Reprimand

3rd- Exceptions Paper & Parent Called

4th- Principal

This order may change at any time up to the discretion of Mrs. Martinez.

CLASSROOM RULES

EXCEPTIONS PAPER

When a student does not meet an expectation in class they will be required to write a paragraph to reflect on the expectation they failed to meet. The paper will count as a daily grade. Failure to complete the paper will result in a zero if it is not turned in by the due date assigned.

- Guidelines:
 - Must Contain a description of the expectation not met, why the student did not meet the expectation, and how the student will resolve the issue.
 - Correct Grammar and Punctuation
 - Parent/ Guardian Signature as well as Student Signature

TUTORIAL POLICY
